For even more choice, the bustling town of Swords offers a shopping centre, dining options, and additional amenities.





The refurbished Smyth's Bridge House itself will feature a bar with an outdoor seating area connecting to an attractive winter garden restaurant.








Live in harmony with nature

The stunning 32 acre Nature Park at Hampden Hill – the size of approximately 24 football fields – is a natural retreat just steps from home. Designed to enhance wellbeing, it offers the freedom to slow down, reconnect with nature and enjoy the luxury of space and fresh air.

With 1.2km of landscaped walkways, tree lined paths, and a cyclepath that seamlessly connects to the Broadmeadow Greenway, the park is perfect for peaceful strolls or invigorating cycles. A dedicated dog park ensures that every member of the family has a place to play.

Extending the connections

Hampden Hill will enjoy even better connections as the DART+ Coastal North project is extending the electrified rail line from Malahide to Donabate and beyond, and is due to be completed in 2026. This will almost double peak time capacity and increase train frequency between Dublin City Centre and Donabate. This means faster, more frequent, and eco friendly journeys – making your daily commute smoother and giving you more time to enjoy life at home.

Walk or cycle across the estuary and beyond

The Broadmeadow Greenway, due for completion in 2027, will be an impressive coastal route linking Donabate and Malahide across the Malahide Estuary. This 6km stretch forms part of the Fingal Coastal Way between the two villages, offering a safe, car-free path for walking, cycling, and enjoying the fresh sea air.



The greenway will connect Newbridge and Malahide Demesnes, creating a seamless link between some of Dublin's most picturesque green spaces. With sweeping estuary views and rich wildlife, it will be a landmark amenity for residents, nature lovers, and outdoor enthusiasts.


